Day 1: Arrival At Baku Azerbaijan

This sacred place serves as a cemetery and memorial dedicated to those who lost their lives during the Black January tragedy caused by the Soviet Army, as well as those who perished in the Nagorno-Karabakh War.

Next, we will continue our journey to Baku Boulevard, a charming promenade that was established back in 1909. This picturesque park runs alongside Bakuâ??s seafront, offering breathtaking views and a serene atmosphere.

Our tour will then take us to the Old City of Baku, known as Icherisheher. Here, we will have the opportunity to witness the grandeur of the Qosha Qala entrance, also referred to as the Shamakhy Gate. Additionally, we will explore notable landmarks such as the St. Nikolay Church, Baku Khanâ??s Residence, Fountain Square, Maiden Tower, Molokan garden, and have a photo stop in front of the magnificent Haydar Aliyev Culture Center.

Get ready to immerse yourself in the rich history and captivating beauty of Baku as we embark on this full day city tour.

Day 3: Explore the Beautiful City of Guba

On the third day of our journey, we will venture to the captivating city of Guba in the north of Azerbaijan. Situated on the northeastern slopes of the majestic Greater Caucasus Mountain Shahdag, Guba boasts an elevation of 600 meters above sea level.

Our first stop will be the remarkable Sakina-Khanum Mosque, constructed in 1854 by the widow of A. Bakikhanov, a renowned Azerbaijani scientist and writer. This grand mosque impresses with its monumental architecture, built entirely from red bricks in the shape of a faceted cylinder. Each facet features a window in the form of a graceful semicircular arch.



Near Guba, we will discover several picturesque natural sites, including the enchanting Gechresh forest. This forest is a popular destination in Azerbaijan, where a road meanders through the trees, providing a panoramic view of the surrounding nature. Take some time to immerse yourself in the tranquility of this serene location.

Next, we will visit the hidden gem of Guba, Chenlibel Lake. This stunning lake remains undiscovered by many locals, offering a serene and picturesque view. Take a moment to appreciate the beauty of this hidden treasure.

Our final destination for the day is the Shahdag Mountain Resort, nestled in a breathtaking area between 1,435 and 2,351 meters above sea level. This resort offers a wide range of recreational, entertainment, and accommodation options, as well as exceptional ski slopes. Prepare to be captivated by the stunning scenery and enjoy the various activities available at this remarkable mountain resort.

Day 4: Absheron Peninsula Half-Day Tour & Baku Night Tour

Located 30 kilometers away from the center of Baku, on the southeastern outskirts of Surakhany village in the Absheron Peninsula, stands the Ateshgah temple, also known as “The House of Fire” or “The Place of Fire”. This temple is renowned for its extraordinary natural phenomenon – the burning of natural gas. When the gas breaks onto the surface and comes into contact with oxygen, it ignites, creating a mesmerizing sight.

The temple itself is a pentagonal structure consisting of 26 cells and one room, surrounded by a battlement. It features an entrance portal with a guest room called balakhane above it. At the center of the courtyard, you will find the rotunda of the temple altar, where an unquenchable fire burns continuously. Adjacent to the temple is a rectangular hole where the bodies of deceased Indians were traditionally cremated in the sacred fire.

In close proximity to this small village, you will discover Mount Yanardagh in the Absheron Peninsula. In the Azerbaijani language, “Yanar” means “burning”, and “Dagh” means “mountain”. True to its name, this is a mountain that is literally on fire. In the past, there were several locations in Absheron where natural gas would spontaneously ignite upon reaching the surface. However, with the widespread extraction of oil and gas in the region, these places gradually disappeared. Mount Yanardagh remains as the sole site where this unique natural phenomenon can still be witnessed – the emergence of natural gas to the surface, resulting in a perpetual flame.

Later on, you will have the opportunity to visit the Heydar Aliyev Cultural Center.

Experience a captivating evening excursion in Baku accompanied by your own personal chauffeur. Explore the prominent landmarks and make stops at your leisure to capture memorable photographs, acquire unique souvenirs, or simply wander through your preferred destinations. Ascend to Highland Park for an awe-inspiring panoramic vista of Baku Bay, offering unparalleled views from the city’s highest vantage point. Journey towards the Flame Towers, an extraordinary trio of skyscrapers symbolizing flames, whose remarkable construction was finalized in 2012. Additionally, during your nocturnal tour of Baku, you have the option to visit Government House, the State Philharmonic Hall, the Mugam Center, or the Carpet Museum. Marvel at the architectural brilliance of the Heydar Aliyev

Center, masterfully crafted by the renowned architect Zaha Hadid. Before returning to your hotel, take a leisurely stroll along Baku Boulevard, which gracefully parallels the city's picturesque waterfront.

Day 5: Transportation from Baku to Gabala

Once you have enjoyed your breakfast at the hotel, it is time to check out. Your chauffeur will be ready to transfer you to Gabala. Upon arrival, you will check in at the Gabala Hotel. You will then have an overnight stay in Gabala.

Day 6: Sheki Day Tour

On the sixth day of your tour, you will explore the captivating city of Sheki, known for its rich historical and cultural heritage. Nestled amidst majestic mountains, Sheki is a city steeped in history. One of the highlights of the tour is a visit to Sheki Khan's Palace, a magnificent structure built in 1762 as a summer retreat for the Khan of Sheki. What makes this palace truly remarkable is the fact that it was constructed without the use of any nails or glues. Inside, the walls are adorned with intricate paintings, each with its own profound philosophical meaning.

As you stroll through the palace gardens, you will come across two ancient plane trees, both of which are over 500 years old. Another fascinating stop on the tour is the Karvansaray, a historical complex consisting of two grand caravanserais known as "Yukhari" and "Ashaghi" caravanserai, meaning "Upper" and "Lower" Caravanserai in Azerbaijani. These caravanserais, dating back to the 18th and 19th centuries, have stood the test of time. The "Lower" caravanserai features a rectangular shape with a spacious inner courtyard, complete with a central pool. Spanning an impressive area of 8000 m² and measuring 55x85 meters, the caravanserai is accessible through four entrances located at each corner of the building.

Day 7: Departure from Gabala to Baku

Begin your day by checking out of your accommodation in Gabala and embarking on a journey to Baku Airport. The approximate duration of this trip is 3-4 hours. Your dedicated chauffeur for the day will ensure a smooth ride and drop you off at the airport. As your tour comes to an end, cherish the sweet memories you have made along the way.
