Explore the Zoological Park, one of India's oldest zoos, set amidst a meticulously planned Botanical Garden teeming with lush greenery, majestic trees, and serene lakes where wild fowl gracefully swim. A reptile house showcasing various snake species is also situated within the premises.

Discover the wonders of science and technology at the Science and Technology Museum Complex, featuring exhibits on science, technology, and electronics.

Immerse yourself in the mysteries of the universe at the Priyadarshiny Planetarium, offering daily shows from 10.00 AM to 5.00 PM.
