Description

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Almaty, the largest city in Kazakhstan, is beautifully nestled at the base of the majestic Trans-Ili Alatau mountains. Meanwhile, Turkistan, a city steeped in history, serves as the administrative center of the Turkistan Region in southern Kazakhstan, positioned close to the Syr Darya River. Located 160 km northwest of Shymkent, it is strategically placed along the Trans-Aral Railway, linking Kyzylorda to the north and Tashkent to the south.

Next, you will journey to Turkistan, home to Kazakhstan's most significant architectural marvel and a revered pilgrimage site.

Upon arrival, check in to your luxurious hotel, nestled within a lavish entertainment complex. The Karavansaray is more than just a place to unwind; it possesses a distinctive essence that promises endless enjoyment through remarkable experiences, discoveries, and a sense of time travel.

This partially unfinished edifice showcases the architectural ingenuity of Persian master builders, whose techniques later influenced the construction of Samarkand, the Timurid Empire's capital. Today, it stands as one of the largest and best-preserved monuments from the Timurid era.

You will then have free time to relax or explore the complex's diverse facilities and entertainment options.
