Day 1: Arrival in Kuala Lumpur & Hotel Check-in

- Shared coach (SIC) transfers involve traveling with other passengers in a communal bus. Please arrive at your designated pickup location or hotel lobby at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time.
- Be prepared for a possible wait of 30 to 45 minutes, influenced by traffic conditions, the hotel's location, and the collection of other guests.
- In shared (SIC) transfers, the maximum waiting time is 5 minutes. The guide or driver will search for you in the lobby or concierge area and may attempt to contact your hotel room.
- If there is no response from your room, the guide or driver will depart after 5 minutes, marking it as a No Show.
- Private transfers do not mean the vehicle is at your disposal; it will only transport you to and from specified attractions at designated times.



- The maximum waiting time for private tours or transfers is 30 minutes from the scheduled pickup. Failure to be present at the pickup point will also be considered a No Show.

- Beginning January 1, 2023, hotels in Malaysia will implement a tourism tax of RM 10 per room per night, payable directly at check-in.
