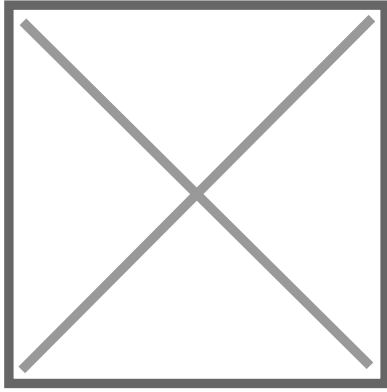




Chandigarh To Pokhara Nepal Package Book Now With Transfers

Further to the west, Pokhara enchants visitors along the shores of Phewa Lake in central Nepal, recognized as the gateway to the illustrious Annapurna Circuit, a highly coveted trekking path in the Himalayas.

The Tal Barahi Temple, an elegant two-story pagoda, is splendidly located on an island within the lake. Along the eastern banks, the Lakeside district features a delightful selection of yoga studios and dining venues. To the south, the International Mountain Museum provides captivating insights into the history of mountaineering and the rich tapestry of cultures found in the Himalayan region.

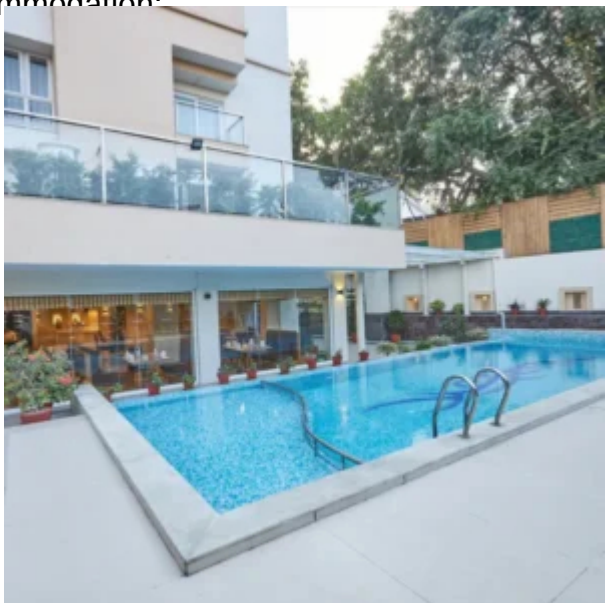

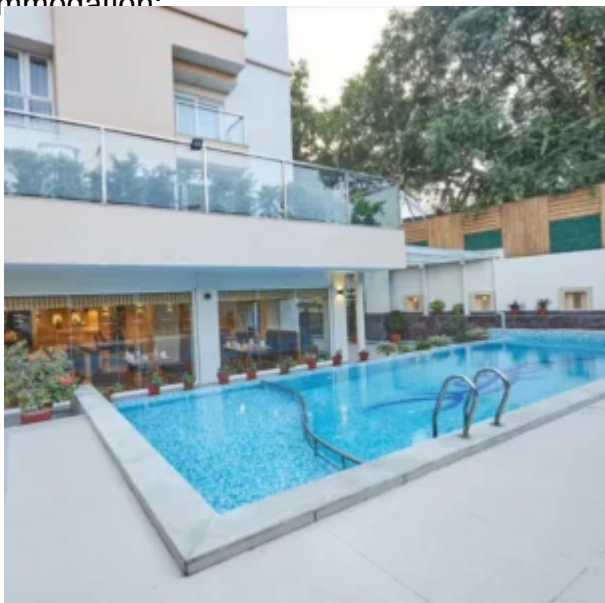

Day Wise Itinerary:

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu

Upon your arrival at the airport, you will be warmly greeted by our dedicated team and escorted to your luxurious hotel. Nestled in a vast valley at the foothills of the majestic Himalayan Range, Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal, showcases a captivating fusion of Hindu and Buddhist artistry and architecture. Enjoy a restful night at your hotel.

Day 02: Discovering the Wonders of Kathmandu

Start your day with a visit to the esteemed Pashupatinath Temple, a pinnacle of Hindu spirituality. Situated along the serene banks of the Bagmati River, this magnificent two-tiered golden temple, embellished with four exquisitely crafted silver doorways, showcases the exceptional craftsmanship of Nepalese temple design. As one of the largest Hindu temple complexes in South Asia, it is home to numerous Shiva lingams and a variety of shrines dedicated to revered Hindu deities.

Following this, we will embark on a journey to Bouddhanath, the most significant Buddhist site in Nepal. This ancient and grand stupa, soaring to approximately 36 meters, ranks among the largest in the nation. It rests upon an impressive three-tiered mandala platform, surrounded by vibrant family residences, creating a captivating ambiance.

In the afternoon, we will delve into the historic Kathmandu Durbar Square and Swayambhunath. The Kathmandu Durbar Square, known locally as Hanuman Dhoka Palace Square, is situated at the heart of the city and was once the royal seat of Nepalese monarchs. This expansive palace complex boasts a stunning collection of temples dedicated to various Hindu deities, with most structures dating from the 15th to the 18th centuries. Our exploration continues at Swayambhunath, gracefully perched on a charming hill. This remarkable stupa, believed to have been built around 250 B.C., provides breathtaking vistas of the Kathmandu Valley and the magnificent northeastern Himalayan range. Conclude your day with a peaceful overnight stay at your hotel.

Day 03: Kathmandu to Chitwan (165 km, approximately 5 - 6 hours drive)

Following a delightful breakfast, embark on your journey to Chitwan. This remarkable destination is celebrated as one of Asia's premier national parks, distinguished by its rich wildlife and luxurious lodges that offer a glimpse into the lives of animals in their natural surroundings. Chitwan, translating to the "heart of the jungle," stands as one of the last remnants of the expansive forests and grasslands that once stretched from the Indus River in Pakistan to the borders of Burma. The crown jewel of this region is Chitwan National Park, one of Asia's largest forested areas, brimming with diverse wildlife, including the rare one-horned rhinoceros, various species of deer, sloth bears, leopards, wild boars, crocodiles, over 350 bird species, and the elusive Royal Bengal Tiger.

In the afternoon, explore the charming Tharu Village and enjoy the breathtaking views at Sunset Point. Overnight accommodations will be at a luxurious hotel.

Day 04: Chitwan Experience

Awaken to the promise of adventure as you embark on an exhilarating elephant-back safari or opt for a thrilling jeep safari that will take you deep into the heart of the mesmerizing Chitwan National Park. This pristine wilderness, teeming with diverse wildlife and lush landscapes, offers an unforgettable encounter with nature. After your morning escapade, return to your elegant hotel where a delightful lunch awaits, featuring a selection of exquisite local and international cuisines.

In the afternoon, immerse yourself in the wonders of the Elephant Breeding Center, where you can learn about the conservation efforts dedicated to these magnificent creatures. Following this enlightening visit, set out on a scenic jungle walk, allowing the tranquility of the surroundings to envelop you. Conclude your day with a serene canoeing experience on the picturesque Rapti River, where the gentle flow of water and the stunning views create a perfect backdrop for relaxation. Day 05: Chitwan to Pokhara (155 km, approximately 5 - 6 hours of travel)

Today, we embark on a scenic drive to the captivating city of Pokhara. Nestled in a serene valley at an elevation of 827 meters, Pokhara serves as the gateway to some of Nepal's most sought-after trekking and rafting adventures. The tranquil waters of Phewa Lake, coupled with the breathtaking backdrop of the iconic Machchhapuchhre peak (6,977 meters), create an enchanting atmosphere filled with peace and wonder. The lush valley surrounding Pokhara boasts dense forests, rushing rivers, pristine lakes, and unparalleled views of the majestic Himalayas. Here, one can marvel at the stunning sights of Dhaulagiri, Manasalu, Machchhapuchhre, and the five peaks of Annapurna, among others. In the afternoon, enjoy a leisurely walking tour around Fewa Lake and visit the picturesque Tal Barahi Temple, situated on an island. Overnight accommodations will be at a luxurious hotel.

Day 06: Exploring Pokhara

Our day will commence with a visit to the Bindebasini Temple, a revered site dedicated to Devi Bhagwati, nestled within the historic park of Pokhara Bazar. Adjacent to the temple lies the Seti River, a stunning natural wonder that flows through the heart of the city. The river's powerful currents and the dramatic gorge it has carved create a breathtaking spectacle. Following this, we will explore Devi's Fall and the Gupteshwor Cave.



Deviâ??s Fall is a striking, seemingly bottomless chasm where the waters of Fewa Lake plunge with a thunderous roar. Directly opposite the fall is Gupteshwor Cave, which stretches nearly 3 kilometers in length. This cave features expansive chambers and narrow passages that require crawling at times. It holds significant importance for Hindus, as it houses a phallic symbol of Lord Shiva in its original state. The afternoon is yours to enjoy leisurely boating or engage in personal pursuits. We will spend the night at a luxurious hotel.

Day 07: Pokhara to Kathmandu (210 km, approximately 6 â?? 7 hours drive)

After a relaxed breakfast, set off on your return journey to Kathmandu, where you will check into your hotel. Spend the day at your own pace, indulging in personal exploration and activities throughout the vibrant city. Your overnight stay will be at the hotel.

Day 08: Departure from Kathmandu

Indulge in a sumptuous breakfast at the hotel before checking out of your room. Afterward, your personal chauffeur will transport you to the international airport for your return journey. As this remarkable tour comes to an end, you will depart with treasured memories in your heart.
