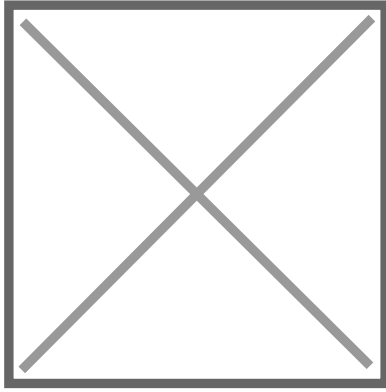

The Pemayangtse Monastery is particularly famous for its stunning wall paintings, intricate sculptures, and a magnificent gold-plated statue of Guru Padmasambhava.

Darjeeling, situated in the Himalayan foothills of West Bengal, India, was once a favored summer retreat for the elite of the British Raj. It continues to be the endpoint for the delightful narrow-gauge Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, affectionately known as the "Toy Train," which was completed in 1881. The region is renowned for its distinctive black tea, cultivated on the verdant plantations that adorn its hillsides, all framed by the majestic presence of Mt. Kanchenjunga, one of the tallest peaks in the world.

Day 1 â?? Bagdogra (IXB) Airport â?? Gangtok

(Distance: 130 km / Travel Time: 5 hours / Elevation of Gangtok: 1,650 meters)

Once you reach Gangtok, you will check in at your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure. Spend a restful night at the hotel in Gangtok.

**Day 2 ??? Journey to Tsomgo Lake & Baba Mandir**

(Distance: One Way to Tsomgo Lake ??? 45 km / Travel Time: 3 hours / Elevation of Tsomgo Lake: 3,780 meters)

(Distance: One Way to Baba Mandir from Tsomgo Lake ??? 16 km / Travel Time: 1 hour / Elevation of Baba Mandir: 4,000 meters)

Following a delightful breakfast, you will embark on a captivating day trip to the enchanting Tsomgo Lake and the revered Baba Mandir. The evening is yours to enjoy at your leisure. You will spend the night at a luxurious hotel in Gangtok.

(Should Tsomgo Lake be inaccessible due to landslides or other unforeseen circumstances, we will arrange alternative sightseeing options.)

Day 3 ??? Journey from Gangtok to Lachung

(Distance: 120 km / Travel Time: 6.5 hours / Elevation of Lachung: 2,700 meters)

Following a delightful breakfast, you will check out of your hotel with minimal luggage and embark on a scenic drive to Lachung in North Sikkim. En route, pause to admire the stunning Naga Waterfall, witness the confluence of the Lachen Chu and Lachung Chu rivers at Chungthang, and enjoy the beauty of Bhim Nala Waterfall. Upon your arrival in Lachung, you will check in at your chosen hotel, resort, or lodge. Enjoy a restful overnight stay in this picturesque destination.

Day 4 ??? Lachung to Yumthang Valley Excursion and Journey to Gangtok

(One Way to Yumthang ??? Distance: 25 km / Travel Time: 1.5 hours / Elevation of Yumthang: 3,560 meters)

At dawn, you will embark on a scenic drive to the enchanting Yumthang Valley, renowned as Sikkim's valley of flowers, celebrated for its breathtaking natural splendor. Nearby, a hot spring awaits, reputed for its therapeutic qualities. After a delightful exploration, you will return to your hotel for lunch before continuing your journey to Gangtok. On a clear day, the return trip offers stunning vistas of Mount Khangchendzonga from the Singhik viewpoint. Upon your arrival in Gangtok, check in at your hotel, where the remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure. Overnight accommodation will be provided at the hotel in Gangtok.

Day 5 ??? Journey from Gangtok to Pelling

(Distance: 160 km / Travel Time: 5.5 hours / Elevation of Pelling: 2,150 meters)

Following breakfast, your journey continues with visits to Ghoom Monastery, Batasia Loop, the Japanese Temple, Peace Pagoda, and the Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park (closed on Thursdays) along with the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (also closed on Thursdays). Experience the Darjeeling Ropeway (ticket cost not included), marvel at Tenzing & Gombu Rock, and explore the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Center (closed on Sundays) and the scenic Tea Garden (outer view). The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure. Overnight accommodation will be at your hotel in Darjeeling.

Day 9 â?? Darjeeling to Bagdogra (IXB) Airport

(Distance: 75 km / Driving Time: 3 hours)

Following a delightful breakfast, you will be escorted to IXB Airport to commence your journey home. This moment signifies the conclusion of your captivating experience in the stunning hills of Darjeeling, as you set your sights on the next adventure. Documentation | Permit Requirement



- Indian Nationals are required to secure permits for entry to Tsomgo Lake, North Sikkim (Lachung & Lachen), and Nathula Pass, incurring an additional fee of Rs 6000 per vehicle plus 5% GST; please be aware that the area is not accessible on Mondays.
- Guests must provide two passport-sized photographs along with original photo identification, which can include a Voter ID, Passport (valid for a minimum of six months), or Driving License (also valid for six months), along with a photocopy for the permit application.
- The PAN Card and Aadhar Card are not valid for permit issuance.
- For children aged five and above, a valid School ID card will suffice.
- It is crucial to carry the original birth certificate in English for children.
- The requirements mentioned apply to a single destination; those planning to visit multiple sites should bring an ample supply of photographs and document photocopies.
- A detailed list containing the Name, Age, and Gender of all travelers, organized by family, is essential for the permit application process.
- Ensure that all necessary documents are prepared ahead of time to ensure a hassle-free permit application experience.
- Guests are advised to verify the validity of their identification documents to prevent any potential issues.
- Proper documentation will significantly enhance the travel experience, ensuring a smooth journey through these stunning locations.
