Ooty, or Udhagamandalam, is a charming resort town nestled in the Western Ghats of Tamil Nadu, southern India. Originally established as a summer retreat during the British Raj, it still boasts a functioning steam railway. The town's colonial heritage is evident in landmarks such as the 19th-century Stone House and the historic St. Stephen's Church, built around 1829. The expansive 55-acre Government Botanical Garden, located on the slopes of Doddabetta Peak, adds to its allure.

Coorg, known as Madikeri, is a picturesque hill town framed by the majestic Western Ghats. It is famous for the Raja's Seat, a modest monument that offers breathtaking views of lush forests and rice fields. The town's centerpiece, the 17th-century Madikeri Fort, is marked by two stone elephants at its entrance. Nearby, the domed Omkareshwar Temple pays homage to the Hindu god Shiva, while the stunning Abbey Falls, surrounded by fragrant spice plantations, cascades nearby.

Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Bangalore and Journey to Mysore via Somnathpur

Upon your arrival at Bangalore Airport or Railway Station, our dedicated representatives will be on hand to assist you with your transfer to Mysore. En route, we will make a delightful stop at Somnathpur to explore the renowned Chennakesava Temple, a magnificent structure commissioned by a general during the reign of Hoysala King Narasimha III in the 1250s. After immersing ourselves in the temple's rich history, we will continue our journey.

As we approach Mysore, prepare to be captivated by this illustrious city, renowned for its ancient temples and monuments that have stood the test of time. History enthusiasts, pilgrims, and travelers alike are drawn to its remarkable ruins and architectural wonders. We will then check in at your pre-arranged hotel for a restful overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 2: A Luxurious Day of Exploration in Mysore with Brindavan Gardens

Indulge in a delightful breakfast this morning before embarking on an exquisite full-day exploration of Mysore, the illustrious capital of Karnataka, celebrated for its vibrant culture and historic architecture. Enthusiasts of history and culture will find themselves enchanted by this city, where ancient structures stand as eloquent narrators of a rich past, complemented by breathtaking vistas and sacred shrines that inspire reverence.

Our journey begins at the Mysore Zoo, an expansive 157-acre sanctuary that showcases a diverse array of wildlife. As you approach, the majestic Chamundi Hills grace the backdrop, enhancing the allure of one of India's oldest zoos. Notably, it is the sole zoo in the country to house a gorilla, alongside orangutans and chimpanzees, making it a favored destination for families. Here, children can engage in an enriching experience, encountering magnificent creatures such as giraffes, zebras, African elephants, bears, white deer, tapirs, otters, and many more.

Next, we will visit the iconic Mysore Palace, also referred to as the Maharaja's Palace, a historical gem that once served as the residence of the Wadiyars. This monument is among the most frequented in Mysore, showcasing remarkable architectural brilliance and housing invaluable artifacts from a bygone era. Surrounded by lush greenery, the palace is primarily constructed of exquisite grey granite and adorned with pink marble domes. A striking 145-foot gilded tower rises above this five-story

beloved abode of the Wadiyars.

Our exploration continues as we ascend to Chamundi Hills, renowned for its elevation and the revered Chamundeshwari Temple. Perched at nearly 3,500 feet, this vantage point offers breathtaking panoramic views of Mysore city, accompanied by a refreshing breeze and invigorating air. Located approximately 13 kilometers from the city, the Chamundeshwari Temple is a celebrated Shakti Peetha, known as the Krouncha Pitha, where Sati's hair is said to have fallen. Here, devotees can worship Shakti in her formidable form as Chamundeshwari.

As we ascend the hills, let us not overlook the renowned Big Bull, an impressive statue of Nandi, the sacred bull associated with Lord Krishna. This remarkable 350-year-old statue stands as one of Mysore's most cherished landmarks. Towering at 16 feet and stretching 24 feet in length, this magnificent Nandi was commissioned by Dodda Devaraja Wodeyar in the mid-1600s.

Next, we shall marvel at the stunning Gothic architecture of St. Philomena's Church. This Catholic edifice, completed in 1936, draws inspiration from the illustrious St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York and ranks among the tallest churches in the region.

Our journey continues to the Jaganmohan Palace, a splendid royal residence that houses an auditorium and an art museum, showcasing a rich collection of historical artifacts. Constructed in 1861 by Mumtaz Ali Wodeyar as a retreat for the royal family, it now boasts the largest assemblage of artifacts in South India since its transformation into a museum.

As evening approaches, we will visit the Krishna Raja Sagara Dam, strategically located at the confluence of three rivers: the Cauvery, Hemavathi, and Lakshmana Thirtha. Established in 1932 under the patronage of Maharaja Krishna Raja Wodeyar IV, this dam serves as the primary water source for Mysore. Adjacent to the dam lies the enchanting Brindavan Gardens, a picturesque haven perfect for leisurely strolls while enjoying the scenic river views. Welcoming over 2 million visitors each year, this free-entry garden features three beautifully terraced levels adorned with vibrant flowers, captivating water fountains, and lush greenery. Be sure to catch the mesmerizing fountain shows, where water dances in harmony with laser displays and music.

After our time in the garden, we will explore the vibrant local market and shopping districts. Immerse yourself in the treasures Mysore has to offer, from exquisite silk saris and sandalwood crafts to fragrant incense sticks, rich coffee, charming wooden toys, and traditional Ganjifa paintings. Following our delightful tour, we will return to the hotel for a restful overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 3: Journey from Mysore to Coorg via Nisargadhama

Following a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on your journey to Coorg, a distance of 120 kilometers that will take approximately three hours.

On your way, make a stop at Bylakuppe, the largest Tibetan settlement in South India, renowned for its stunning Golden Temple, also known as the Namdroling Monastery. This site showcases remarkable Tibetan architecture and artistry, featuring a beautifully adorned temple tower and intricately designed outer walls embellished with exquisite murals. The striking red doors are complemented by grand golden knockers. Inside, you will be awed by the towering 40-foot golden statues of Guru Padmasambhava, Buddha Sakyamuni, and Amityaus, all surrounded by captivating paintings that depict various elements of Tibetan Buddhist mythology.

Next, visit Cauvery Nisargadhama, a picturesque island formed by the River Cauvery, celebrated as a popular picnic destination. Access the island via a charming hanging rope bridge, where you will find lush bamboo groves, sandalwood, and teak trees. The area boasts a deer park, Rabbit Park, Peacock Park, and an Orchidarium. You may also indulge in boating and an elephant ride, available at an additional cost.

Upon arrival in Coorg, check in to your hotel and unwind. This enchanting hill station in Karnataka, often referred to as the Scotland of India, is famous for its misty hills, verdant forests, tea and coffee plantations, orange orchards, winding roads, and breathtaking vistas. Enjoy an overnight stay at your chosen hotel or resort in Coorg.

Day 4: Full Day Exploration of Madikeri with a Visit to Tala Kaveri

After a delightful breakfast, embark on a journey to Tala Kaveri, the revered source of the Cauvery River, nestled on the eastern slopes of Brahmagiri Peak at an impressive altitude of 1,350 meters. A trek through the Brahmagiri hills offers stunning vistas of the surrounding ranges, perfect for capturing memorable photographs. Although the ascent is steep, it is manageable for those willing to embrace the challenge. Following this, visit Bhagamandala, where the Cauvery and Kanika rivers converge, with the Sujoythi river said to emerge from underground. Here, pay your respects at the Bhagandeshwara Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, and receive his blessings.

After lunch, proceed to Abbey Falls, located just 8 kilometers from Madikeri town. This enchanting waterfall, set amidst lush coffee plantations and spice estates, is one of the most picturesque in the Coorg region. Abbey Falls plunges 70 feet down rocky slopes into a serene pool below. A hanging bridge spans the gorge, offering visitors a stunning view of the cascading waters. Don't miss the Kali Mata temple situated on the opposite side of the bridge. The pathway leading to the falls is adorned with dense vegetation, providing a truly immersive experience for those who missed it the previous day.

Next, explore the Madikeri Fort (closed on Mondays), a historical gem that retains its timeless charm. This iconic landmark showcases remarkable architectural design and construction styles. Within its walls, you will find the Madikeri Fort Museum and the Kote Maha Ganapathi Temple. The fort's elevated structures offer breathtaking panoramic views of the town, a sight that is simply captivating.

Finally, visit the Sri Omkareshwar Temple, an ancient shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in the heart of Madikeri. The temple is notable for its unique architectural blend of Gothic and Islamic influences, making it a remarkable site to behold.

Rajaâ??s Seat, translating to the â??Seat of Kings,â?• is an exquisite structure supported by four elegant pillars. Nestled within a magnificent garden adorned with seasonal blooms and enchanting musical fountains, it serves as a favored vantage point. The ideal moments to experience Rajaâ??s Seat are at dawn and dusk, when the vistas of sunrise and sunset are truly mesmerizing. Additionally, children can delight in a charming Toy Train ride that offers stunning views of the surrounding mountains. Afterward, return to your hotel to unwind and enjoy a restful overnight stay in Coorg.

Day 5: Journey from Coorg to Ooty

Following a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on your journey to Ooty, covering a distance of 224 kilometers in approximately six hours. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and take some time to unwind. Ooty, often referred to as â??The Queen of Hillsâ?• in South India, is perched at an impressive altitude of 2,240 meters above sea level. The Nilgiri Mountain Railway, which links Ooty to Mettupalayam, is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy an overnight stay at your hotel in Ooty.

Day 6: A Day of Enchantment in Ooty & Coonoor

After a delightful breakfast, embark on a captivating full-day excursion to the enchanting hill stations of Ooty and Coonoor, nestled within the breathtaking Nilgiri Hills, just 20 kilometers apart and perfect for a single dayâ??s exploration.

Begin your morning at Simâ??s Park, a botanical haven perched at an elevation of 1,780 meters. Established in 1874, this garden boasts over 1,000 species of flora, including the majestic Queensland Karry Pine, the revered Rudraksha tree, and a variety of ornamental trees. Stroll through the verdant landscape adorned with vibrant blooms, indulge in serene boating experiences, and capture the beauty through your lens.

Next, visit Lambâ??s Rock, situated en route to Dolphinâ??s Nose in Ooty, also known as Echo Rock. This favored picnic destination offers breathtaking vistas of the Coimbatore Plains and the surrounding lush greenery, with trekking opportunities along the scenic route.

Continue your journey to Dolphinâ??s Nose, located just 10 kilometers from Coonoor. This peak provides mesmerizing views of the Nilgiri Hills and the cascading Catherine Falls, its shape reminiscent of a dolphinâ??s nose, lending it its unique name.

Explore the Botanical Garden, a sprawling expanse reminiscent of a golf course, ascending steeply and showcasing a diverse array of trees and shrubs, alongside conservatories filled with exotic ferns and flowering plants. A remarkable highlight is the fossilized tree, a natural exhibit dating back approximately 20 million years, as revealed by carbon dating.

Next, visit the Rose Garden, the largest of its kind in India, featuring over 20,000 varieties of roses sourced from around the globe, including the rare black and green roses. From this garden, enjoy a stunning panoramic view of Ooty.



As the day winds down, make your way to Ooty Lake, an artificial gem and one of the region's most popular attractions. After a day filled with exploration, return to your hotel to unwind and enjoy a restful overnight stay in Ooty.

Day 7: Journey from Ooty to Bangalore for Departure

After a delightful breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on a scenic drive to Bangalore Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey (350 km/8 hours).
