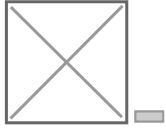

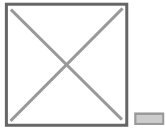

Day 3: Mt. Fuji Excursion and Hakone Tour with Hakone Pirate Ship

Please note that the Sky Palace is closed from December to March. However, if you are visiting during this period, you will have the opportunity to visit the snow resort at Mt. Next, you will visit the Gotemba Premium Outlets, where you can indulge in some shopping and capture beautiful photos. Following this, you will have a delicious lunch at an Indian restaurant.

After lunch, you will embark on the Hakone Ropeway cable car, which will take you on a scenic journey through the Ashikudani Valley. This valley is known for its volcanic activity, providing a unique and captivating sightseeing experience. You will also visit Jigokudani, famous for its black eggs. These eggs are boiled in the sulphurous waters, resulting in their distinctively colored shells.

To further enhance your Hakone experience, you will embark on a cruise from Togendai Port to Moto Hakone Port. This cruise will take you along the picturesque Ashinoko Lake on the Hakone Pirate Ship, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape.

• The itinerary may be modified due to unforeseen circumstances like inclement weather or heavy traffic. No refunds will be given in such situations.

• Any additional hour beyond the allotted time will incur a charge of USD 40 for the guide and USD 60 for the vehicle. However, the overtime should not exceed 1 hour (maximum of 11 hours per day).

• Double rooms can only be requested but are not guaranteed.

• Indian lunches, dinners, and local meals are pre-set and cannot be altered once confirmed.

• The remitter is responsible for bearing any bank charges.

• Coach and guide services are available for a maximum of 11 hours per day.

• According to Japanese Law, coach and guide services must conclude by 2100 hrs.

• The driver must take a 30-minute break after every 5 hours of driving.
