Day Wise Itinerary:

Day 1: Greetings from Auckland

Welcome to Auckland, the City of Sails in New Zealand. Flights can arrive at any time before 4.00pm, and upon arrival, you will be transferred from the airport to your hotel. Once you have checked in, take the opportunity to explore Auckland. Stroll along Queen Street, the main shopping precinct, or hop on a bus (which departs from outside the hotel) to the Viaduct Harbour and the Auckland Waterfront area. This newly developed part of central Auckland offers a plethora of cafes and restaurants. Find a spot in the sunshine, savor a glass of New Zealand's renowned Sauvignon Blanc, and observe the bustling maritime activity on Waitemata Harbour. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome reception at your hotel.

Day 2: Auckland to Rotorua

Begin your day in Auckland with a city sights tour. Take in the breathtaking views of Auckland City and the Waitemata Harbour from the Auckland War Memorial Museum. As you leave Auckland, follow the winding path of the Waikato River to reach the Waitomo Caves. Explore the extraordinary limestone caverns and glide through the serene waters of the enchanting Glow Worm Grotto. Continuing your journey from Waitomo to Rotorua, you will pass through the historic King Country region, which played a significant role in the New Zealand Wars of the 1860s. Upon arrival in Rotorua, embark on an orientation tour that offers stunning vistas of Lake Rotorua. Tonight, immerse yourself in a captivating evening of culture, history, and delectable cuisine at the Tamaki Maori Village. Take a stroll through the ancient forest village and gain insights into Maori art forms and traditions. Then, be enthralled by a concert featuring talented local performers. Indulge in an authentic Maori Hangi meal, cooked underground in the traditional manner.

Day 3: Rotorua Leisure Time



Today presents an opportunity for you to immerse yourself in the breathtaking natural wonders of Rotorua's geothermal wonderland. You have the option to embark on an exploration of Rainbow Springs Nature Park & The National Kiwi Hatchery, where you can take a fascinating "behind the scenes" tour of the operational kiwi nursery and hatchery. Alternatively, you can visit Te Puia and partake in a guided tour of the Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve, which is home to the renowned Pohutu Geyser and the mesmerizing mud pools. As the day progresses, you may also consider indulging in the therapeutic hot mineral waters of the Polynesian Spas, allowing yourself more time to revel in the marvels of the thermal landscape. Rest assured, your guide will be on hand to assist you in arranging all of your desired optional experiences.

Day 4: Rotorua to Wellington

Bid farewell to Rotorua this morning and embark on a journey through pine forests and farmland towards a hidden gem, the vibrant rapids of Huka Falls. The road ahead reveals a breathtaking view of Lake Taupo, the largest lake in New Zealand, with its mesmerizingly azure freshwater renowned for its exceptional trout fishing. Continuing south, you will traverse the Central Plateau, the country's primary volcanic region. Amidst the diverse landscapes, the three majestic peaks of Tongariro National Park dramatically emerge from the surrounding tussock-covered plateau, creating a captivating sight. En route to Wellington, you will pass through several charming small towns, each possessing its own distinct character and peculiarities. Among them, Taihape stands out as the self-proclaimed gumboot capital of the world, adding a touch of quirkiness to the journey. Following the Kapiti Coast, a beloved summer destination for Wellington's residents, the state highway eventually leads you to New Zealand's capital city, Wellington.

Day 5: Wellington to Picton

Following a comprehensive city tour of Wellington, which includes a visit to New Zealand's parliament buildings and the renowned Te Papa Museum, take some time to relax and enjoy the city at your own pace. Immerse yourself in Wellington's famous coffee culture or take a leisurely stroll along Lambton Quay, the bustling heart of the city's central business district. Today, lunch will be provided by "Eat My Lunch", a charitable organization that ensures school children in New Zealand receive a nutritious meal. By partaking in this lunch, you are making a valuable contribution to a child in need. In the afternoon, your guide will accompany you on the Interislander cruise, crossing the Cook Strait from the North Island to the South Island. Surprisingly, the journey through the Tory Channel and Queen Charlotte Sound to Picton takes longer than crossing the open ocean of Cook Strait. As you navigate through a labyrinth of arms and inlets, you will arrive at the tranquil coastal village of Picton. Tonight, savor a delightful dinner at your hotel.

Day 6: Picton to Christchurch

Embark on a journey to Kaikoura, a place renowned for its frequent sightings of Sperm Whales near the coastline. Consider taking an optional whale-watching flight for an even more immersive experience. Continue your travel along the picturesque Pacific Ocean coast and traverse the vibrant Canterbury Plains until you reach Christchurch. In the evening, take the opportunity to consult your guide for excellent dining suggestions within the heart of Christchurch's inner city.

Day 7: Omarama to Christchurch

Before departing, you have the option to explore the city center and Cathedral Square in Christchurch. Witness the ongoing reconstruction efforts following the devastating earthquakes of 2010 and 2011. Don't forget to visit the Transitional Cathedral in Latimer Square, a unique structure made primarily of cardboard. Embark on a city sights tour of Christchurch before venturing out into the picturesque Canterbury Plains. Marvel at the breathtaking views of Lake Tekapo, with its turquoise waters set against a backdrop of rugged hills and snow-capped mountains. Take a moment to visit the charming stone-hewn Church of the Good Shepherd and pay homage to the collie dog statue, a tribute to the sheepdogs that played a vital role in the development of the Mackenzie Country. If you choose, you can also opt for a scenic flight over Mount Cook National Park, the Southern Alps, and the Franz Josef and Fox Glaciers (additional cost applies). The day concludes in the heart of the Mackenzie Country, in Omarama, where you can enjoy a delicious dinner at your hotel.

Day 8: Omarama to Dunedin

Commence your day by embarking on a scenic journey alongside the Waitaki River, which serves as the dividing line between the Canterbury and Otago regions. This river boasts a substantial catchment area, making it an excellent source of hydro-electric power. Following your exploration of the Waitaki Valley, proceed to the charming township of Oamaru. Here, you will be greeted by elegant tree-lined streets and renowned white limestone structures. The locals of Oamaru took great pride in supplying limestone for the construction of Town Halls and churches in major cities such as Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin, ensuring that their own town showcased the finest examples of limestone architecture from the mid to late 1800s. In the afternoon, continue your journey to Dunedin, the southernmost city in New Zealand. With the remainder of your free time, you may opt to partake in an optional excursion to further explore the region. Consider embarking on a Wildlife Cruise to Otago Peninsula, visiting the esteemed Speights Brewery – a beloved New Zealand establishment, or embarking on a ride aboard the historic Taieri Gorge Railway.

Day 9: Dunedin to Te Anau

Today in Dunedin, you will have some leisure time to explore the city. One option is to visit the stunning Larnach Castle, which happens to be the only castle in New Zealand. Alternatively, you can take a stroll through the picturesque grounds of Otago University, the country's first university. Known as the Edinburgh of the South, Dunedin has a strong connection to its sister city in the northern hemisphere, even sharing similar street names. Take a leisurely walk along George Street and appreciate Dunedin's Scottish heritage.

In the afternoon, you will travel through lush green pastures, passing through sheep-filled farmland. New Zealand is renowned for its sheep farming, and these landscapes are iconic representations of the country. Don't miss the opportunity to capture the perfect sheep photo! As your journey continues, the rolling hills transform into dense forests and rugged mountains, leading you to the Fiordland National Park. Here, you will discover the South Island's largest lake and the charming town of Te Anau.

In the evening, you will have the option to embark on a tour to the Glow Worm Caves, located across the lake (additional cost). This unique experience allows you to witness the mesmerizing glow worms in their natural habitat. Finally, enjoy a delicious dinner at your hotel.

Day 10: Te Anau to Queenstown

Today is a day that calls for a fully charged camera battery and a sense of awe. Departing from Te Anau, you will embark on a journey through the breathtaking Fiordland National Park, making your way to Milford Sound along a scenic road that will leave you speechless. Along the way, you will pass through native rainforests, beech forests, alluvial flats, and meadows, immersing yourself in the natural beauty of the surroundings. Make a stop at Mirror Lakes, where the tranquil waters perfectly mirror the stunning mountain scenery, creating a picturesque sight. Continuing on, you will encounter the Homer Tunnel, a testament to man's determination to conquer the rugged mountain ranges. As you emerge from the tunnel, you will be greeted by one of the most awe-inspiring alpine drives in the world, descending through the picturesque Cleddau Valley. Take a moment to visit the Chasm, where the powerful Cleddau River has carved its way through solid rock, showcasing nature's raw power. Finally, arrive at Milford Sound, a natural wonder that will leave you in awe. Embark on a cruise through the sound, marveling at the majestic Bowen and Stirling Falls as they cascade from glacial hanging valleys into the sea. Witness the grandeur of Mitre Peak, rising majestically from the deep waters of the fiord. After experiencing the spectacular beauty of Milford Sound, continue your journey to the enchanting sights of Queenstown. Take an orientation tour along the shores of Lake Wakatipu, allowing you to appreciate the city's charm and beauty.

Day 11: Queenstown Leisure Time

Experience the wonders of Queenstown at your own pace! Take the opportunity to immerse yourself in the legend of Queenstown by embarking on an exhilarating ride aboard the Shotover Jet Boat or going on a scenic tour of Skippers Canyon. If you prefer a more relaxed and laid-back experience, treat yourself to a Wine Tour and indulge in the exquisite flavors of Central Otago's award-winning wines. Alternatively, visit Queenstown's Kiwi Birdlife Park to admire our native bird species. Our knowledgeable guide will be available to assist you in arranging all of your preferred optional activities. After a day filled with excitement, unwind and enjoy a peaceful evening cruise across Lake Wakatipu on the TSS Earnslaw, New Zealand's oldest steamship. Launched in 1912, the TSS Earnslaw is the largest and most magnificent vessel to have ever sailed on Lake Wakatipu. It is also the only coal-fired passenger-carrying vessel still in operation in the southern hemisphere. Indulge in a delicious gourmet BBQ Highlight Dinner at Walter Peak's Colonel's Homestead, followed by an entertaining after-dinner farm show that provides a glimpse into the fascinating world of high-country farm life. On the return cruise to Queenstown, join in a nostalgic sing-along or share a dance with your partner on the polished wooden floors of the Earnslaw.

Day 12: Queenstown to Franz Josef

Today, you will bid farewell to the stunning alpine paradise of Queenstown and embark on a journey through Central Otago towards Westland. On your way out of Queenstown, make a stop at the meticulously restored gold mining settlement of Arrowtown. Strolling along the picturesque tree-lined streets, passing by charming 19th century wooden buildings, you will feel as if you have stepped into a movie set.

Continuing your journey, you will head to Cromwell, located next to the glistening waters of Lake Dunstan. Take a break at a local orchard and indulge in the delectable stone fruits that the town is known for. Today's itinerary is filled with breathtaking lakes. After Dunstan, you will venture further into Central Otago and marvel at the vibrant blue waters of Lake Hawea, followed by the enchanting shoreline of Lake Wanaka adorned with poplars and willows.

Following an ancient greenstone trail, you will cross Haast Pass, transitioning from the alpine landscapes of the Southern Lakes to the awe-inspiring rainforests of the wild West Coast. Take in the dramatic Thunder Creek Falls and the majestic sight of Mt Hooker, surrounded by vast glaciers on three sides. Our final destination for the day is the extraordinary Franz Josef Glacier, a network of rivers of ice. For an up-close experience, consider taking a helicopter flight that will hover over the snow-covered face and potentially land high up in the valley, allowing you to walk across the ice fall (subject to weather conditions, additional cost applies).

In the evening, enjoy a delightful dinner at your hotel.

Day 13: Franz Josef & Christchurch

In the event of unfavorable weather conditions on Day 15, you will have another opportunity to fly up to the glaciers in the morning or explore the charming Franz Josef village. Afterwards, you will continue your journey to the picturesque drift-wood covered beaches of Hokitika. Hokitika not only embraces its coastal landscape but also thrives in its rich resources. During your visit, you will have the chance to explore a pounamu factory, where skilled carvers create exquisite pieces of jewelry and art from native greenstone or jade. According to Maori tradition, it is considered bad luck to purchase pounamu for oneself, so if you desire a trinket, ensure you have someone with you to make the purchase. From Hokitika, you will travel inland to the quaint settlement of Arthur's Pass. Here, you will embark on the TranzAlpine train, a remarkable journey that has been captivating travelers since 1914. Renowned as one of the world's most scenic train trips, the TranzAlpine train takes you through tunnels, over viaducts, and offers breathtaking views of snow-capped peaks, icy rivers, beech forests, gorges, and river valleys. In the evening, join your AAT Kings Travel Director, Driver, and newfound friends for a Farewell Dinner.

Day 14: Farewell From Christchurch

Your New Zealand holiday comes to an end this morning after breakfast. You have the flexibility to depart at any time today, and arrangements will be made to transfer you to Christchurch Airport for your onward flight.
