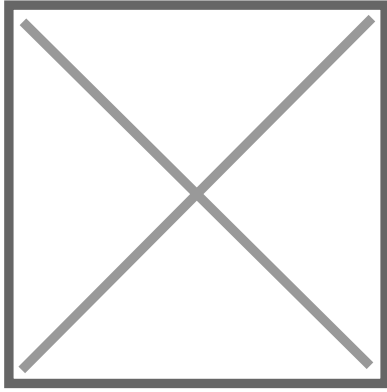

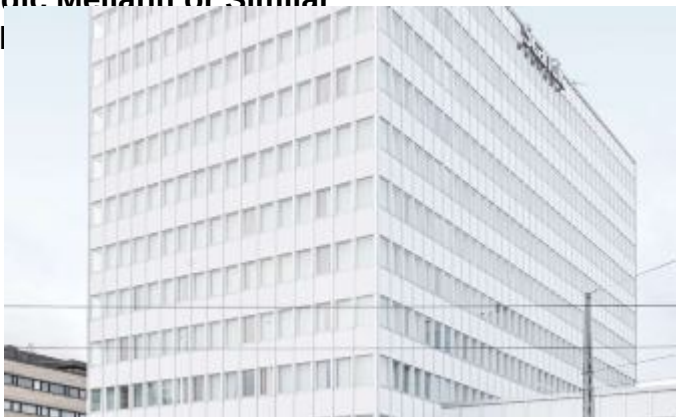

Day 1: Arrival in Tallinn
