Day 1: Arrival in Istanbul

Upon entering the palace complex, immerse yourself in the splendor of the meticulously maintained gardens that envelop the palace, offering a serene ambiance. Additionally, marvel at the captivating

views of the Bosphorus. Before entering the palace itself, take a moment to appreciate the working flower clock and the exquisite Imperial Gate situated on the left.

The villageâ??s houses are intricately built around the extensive network of tunnels, making it one of the most fascinating underground settlements in Cappadocia. Originally consisting of eight floors, you will have the opportunity to explore four of them. During times of war, this underground city could shelter up to 5000 people. Today, the tunnels serve as storage areas, stables, and cellars, preserving the rich history of this remarkable place.

Day 6: Cappadocia â?? Antalya â?? by flight â?? Turkish Night

After having breakfast, check out of your hotel in Istanbul. You will then be picked up from your hotel and transferred to Istanbul airport for your flight to Antalya, which serves as a gateway to the Turkish Riviera. Antalya is a beautifully preserved historical city and port, nestled in a crescent-shaped bay surrounded by the Taurus Mountains. The grand theater of this ancient city, constructed on colonnaded arches, stands as the largest in the entire region. As the tour concludes, you will be transported back to your hotel at approximately 5:45 pm. Rest and relax in Antalya for the night.
