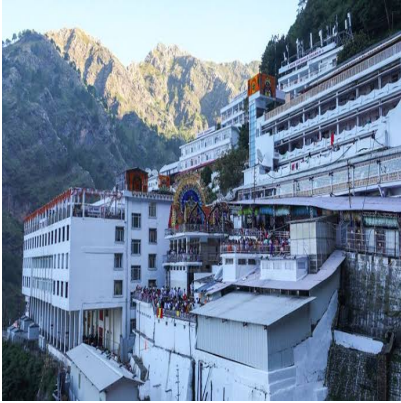




Vaishno Devi Pilgrimage With Kashmir Tour Package From Zirakpur Punjab

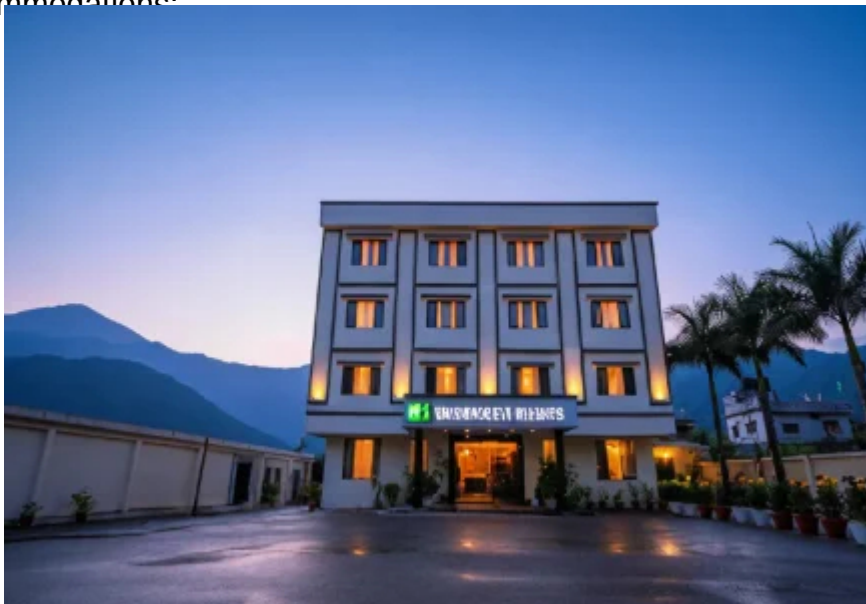

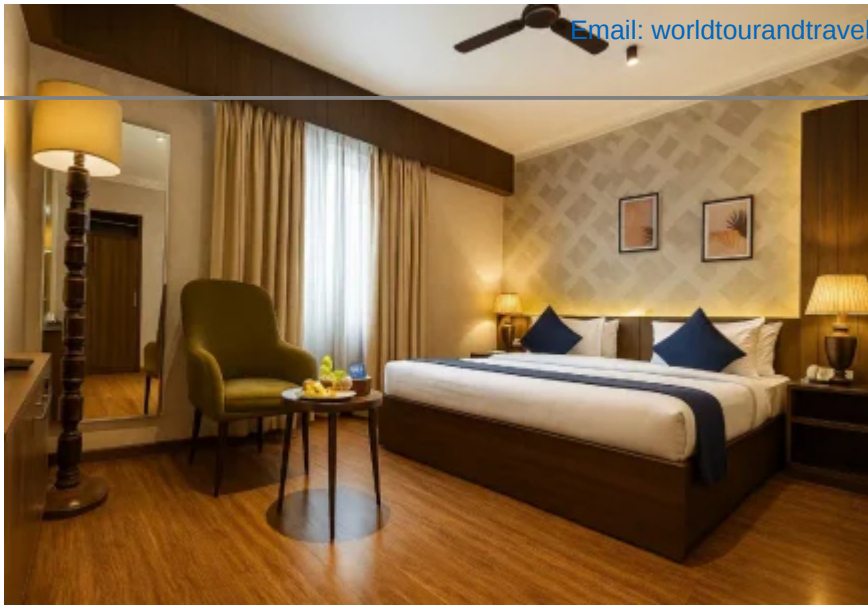

Day 01 â?? Jammu â?? Katra

Upon your arrival at Jammu airport or railway station, you will be warmly welcomed by our representative. Following this cordial greeting, you will embark on a scenic drive to Katra. Following a delightful breakfast, embark on a scenic trek of 13.5 kilometers to the revered shrine of Mata Shri Vaishno Devi Jee for a spiritually enriching darshan. After immersing yourself in the divine experience, return in the evening. Enjoy a restful overnight stay at your hotel in Katra.

Day 03: Katra to Pahalgam (Approximately 226 kilometers, a journey of 6 hours)

Following a delightful breakfast, embark on your scenic drive to Pahalgam. Upon arrival, check into your luxurious hotel. The day offers an opportunity to explore the renowned attractions of Pahalgam, including the picturesque Aru, Chandanwari, and the enchanting Betaab Valley, accessible via a taxi from the local union (additional costs applies). As the evening approaches, return to your hotel in Pahalgam for a sumptuous dinner and a restful overnight stay.

Day 04: Pahalgam to Srinagar (Approximately 90 kilometers, 2-3 hours of travel)

Day 05: Exploring the Charms of Srinagar

During your visit, take the opportunity to explore the breathtaking sights, including a ride on Asia's largest cable car to Aparwath (available at an additional cost). In the evening, return to your hotel in Srinagar for a sumptuous dinner and a restful overnight stay.

Day 07: Excursion to Sonmarg (Approximately 80 kilometers, 2-3 hours of travel)

Following a delightful breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to Sonmarg, a captivating destination that serves as the gateway to remarkable treks leading to the breathtaking high-altitude lakes of the Himalayas. During your visit, indulge in the renowned sights of Sonmarg, including the majestic Thajwas Glacier, which can be explored via pony or horse (additional costs may apply). As the day draws to a close, return to Srinagar for a sumptuous dinner and a restful overnight stay.

Day 08: Exploration of the City & Departure from Srinagar Airport

Following a delightful breakfast, indulge in personal pursuits such as shopping or a captivating local city tour. This excursion may encompass visits to the iconic Jamia Masjid, the revered Hazratbal Shrine, the enchanting Badamwari, and, time permitting, the historic Hariparbat Fort. Conclude your day with a timely transfer to Srinagar Airport, ensuring your arrival two hours ahead of your flight's departure.

Please Note:

Kindly be informed that, in accordance with the regulations set forth by the Taxi Union, our vehicle is not permitted to conduct sightseeing tours in Gulmarg, Pahalgam, and Sonmarg. Guests are required to hire a union vehicle, which will be on a direct payment basis. Alternatively, we can facilitate this arrangement for you at an additional cost, as specified in the Package Cost Exclude section.

Exclusions:

- Exclusions from the package cost include lunch options (vegetarian and non-vegetarian) at a renowned restaurant, priced at ₹1550 per person.
- Entry fees for gardens and monuments are set at ₹1500 per person.
- Pony or horse rides to Baisaran, Kashmir, Dnow, and Dabyab Valley in Pahalgam are available for ₹1,500 per person.
- Access to Tuliyan Lake in Pahalgam via pony or horse is priced at ₹2,500 per person.



- Transportation to Aru Valley, Betaab Valley, and Chandanwari in Pahalgam via union vehicle costs ₹13,000 or can be arranged with a private cab.
- Gondola ride tickets for the first phase at Gulmarg are available for ₹1800 per person.
- For both the first and second phases of the gondola ride at Gulmarg, tickets are priced at ₹1,800 per person.
- Pony or horse rides to Thajwas Glacier in Sonmarg are offered at ₹1,500 per person.
- During winter, a 4x4 jeep is necessary to reach Gulmarg from Tanmarg due to heavy snowfall, with a supplementary cost of ₹13,000 for a private cab.
- Honeymoon complimentary services are provided once during the houseboat stay, at a cost of ₹1,000 per person, along with any other items not specified in the inclusions.
