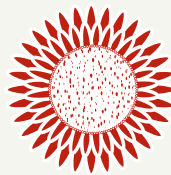

TOP PLACES TO VISITS

HO CHI MINH

Vibrating with energy, innovation and traffic – lots of traffic – Ho Chi Minh City, formerly known as Saigon, is the economic heart of Vietnam and the main hub of the southern region

TOP PLACES TO VISITS

HOI AN

A Place where the bold march of progress peters into a leisurely amble. Outside the Old Town, two-lane roads slice through waving rice fields and emerge at a frothy coastline.



HANOI

A renowned destination for typical cuisine, home to fascinating attractions and hospitable people, and a diverse region with a combination of multi-communities. There is plenty to enjoy in Hanoi, from mouthwatering street food to fascinating history, from traditional entertainment to recreational activities.



TOP SIGHTSEEING - HO CHI MINH

Reunification Palace, also known as Independence Palace, is listed as a historical monument by witnessing great changes of Ho Chi Minh City's history and having in itself the essence of Eastern culture.

Notre Dame Cathedral, The Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica of Saigon is one of the city's most loved and important landmarks. Officially known as the Cathedral Basilica of the Lady of the Immaculate Conception, it still retains the aura of grand bygone eras and holy sanctity.

Cu Chi Tunnels, One of the most iconic attractions of the city, Cu Chi Tunnels were a part of the extensive underground network in Vietnam that was used by the Vietnamese Congress as a hideaway during the war.



TOP SIGHTSEEING - DANANG

Nha Trang, Apart from the sights and the beaches, delicious local dishes also play a huge factor in the whole trip experience. The cuisine of Nha Trang can be seen as a representative of the central region.

Da Lat, a refreshing hill station located in the southwestern highlands of Vietnam. It is known as the 'City of Eternal Spring' for its distinctive temperate climate.

A far cry from the tropical heat of the south, Da Lat's crisp and cool weather attracts honeymooners, backpackers as well as luxury travellers.



TOP SIGHTSEEING - HOI AN

Ngu Hanh Son is about 8 km away from the center of Da Nang City. This is the masterpiece that the nature gave Da Nang City. From above, Ngu Hanh Son resembles the sky's hand to affirm here is the sacred land.

Huyen Khong cave, Located in the tourist complex of the Marble Mountains, Huyen Khong is one of the most beautiful and spiritual places in the central city of Da Nang.

Cham Buddha, A UNESCO World Heritage Site in Vietnam, known for its collection of ruins of over seventy ancient Hindu temples. These temples were constructed between 4th and 14th AD by Champa rulers and display the strong heritage of the Cham Clan.



TOP SIGHTSEEING - HANOI

Sapa town stands at the head of a deep valley of magnificent rice terraces that are still farmed today as they have been for centuries. Enticing ribbons of road lead the eye down to the valley floor, white-water rivers rush among rice fields, and lush green mountains stretch into the distance as far as the eye can see.

Ninh Binh, from ancient temples to hidden caves and verdant rice paddies, Ninh Binh offers impressive natural landscapes as the most majestic scenery in Southeast Asia. Also with striking limestone outcrops, Ninh Binh has earned its nickname “Ha Long Bay on land” that featured in the latest Kong movie.

VIETNAM VISA

Getting a business or tourist visa to Vietnam is simple at Vietnam Visa. It's a 3 Step process and One can easily apply for it online on their official website.

It is electronically issued; a Single Entry Visa that must be requested at least two (2) days prior to the departure date.

So what is the best time to visit Vietnam? Generally, the best time of year to visit Vietnam is around March - April and October - December when the weather is comfortable and plenty of festivals occur in the whole country.
